2013, Community School Coordinator Report – Wednesday, September 18th

- AMA(Alberta Motor Association) Safety patrollers have started- Gr.5-6 students
 volunteer to participate in 15 minute shifts twice a day for on full week to provide a
 better understanding of pedestrian safety. New AMA school safety patrol training
 session beginning in October time & date TBA...
- CSO Programs are being developed, sign up sheet will be set home this month in separate newsletter from Community School Office (one time only)
- Big Brothers/Big Sisters orientation a list of 7 student names have been received from Mrs. Beauchesne School Counselor. Partnership agreement with Jillian Uttley of BB/BS has been signed for 2013/14. One Grade 6 student renewing agreement and six new students are being processed.
- Classroom budget \$100.00 for school year money is used to enhance experience's for the students – teacher materials are through school-based budget with Mrs. Gordon
- Kidsport program helps low income,unemployed,currently receiving income support through Prov.gov. (children,youth up to 18 yrs.) costs related to dance,camps,travel,championships,high performance do not qualify. To participate in registered sport programs with qualified instructors (\$750 per yr)
- Jumpstart program sponsored by Canadian Tire helps financially disadvantage kids (ages 4-18) participate in organized sport and recreation by covering registration, equipment and/or transportation
- Creative Kids(Saskatchewan residence) modeled after the Kidsport but this program
 is a charitable giving program designed to reduce financial barriers for children and
 youth (ages 4-19) who wish to participate in arts and cultural programming. (\$750. per
 vr)
- Breakfast, hot lunch and snacks have started, students can be sent directly to kitchen to receive their food from Mrs. Haugen....collection of money to Community School Office, please.
- Midwest Family Connections are starting their family programs which will run in the mornings in our servery once a week, plus evening parenting planning groups are getting geared for Tuesday evenings dates & times TBA.
- Lloydminster Learning Council has a 1.2.3. Rhyme with Me program scheduled to begin February 2014 to run in our servery – see JK Calendar
- Summer Reading Program winners receive a personal size pizza ,book,Smithy's coupon on Friday ,September 20th Period 4. We will need two volunteers to assist in handing out 62 personal size pizzas and prizes to each classroom.
 - SCC volunteers for BBQ and volunteers set up.
 - SCC volunteers for Family Potluck dinners beginning on September 24th from 5-6:30pm in the gym. Informal presentations, craft, games and food available.
