

Bus Zone

Jack Kemp Community School has various transportation plans throughout the entire school day including the regular busing schedule, busing for our prekindergarten program and many fieldtrips. The bus zone in front of the school is to be reserved for busses only, including before and after school.

Please do not park in this area at any time. Thank you for your cooperation.

Crosswalks and Safety Patrollers

Many students and families frequently use the crosswalks in front of and around our school throughout the day. Please be mindful of the 30 km/hour speed zone, yield to pedestrians and respect the signals of our student Safety Patrollers.

Our Safety Patrollers 'point' their arms to indicate someone wants to cross, call across to each other when it is safe, then extend their stop signs when pedestrians may cross.

Please avoid parking in marked crosswalks and respect laws for leaving distance between your vehicle and the crosswalks.

School Community Council We encourage parents to attend our School Community Council meetings and to volunteer to assist with activities. The SCC works to support school goals for learning and student wellness. We will meet the 3rd Wednesday of each month, with our first meeting being on Wednesday, September 20th from 12:10 - 12:55 p.m. Lunch will be served and childcare is available.
