5. School Report:

- Mrs. Gordon & Mrs. Mather will be attending a meeting at a 'trauma based' school in Edmonton to see what information they can learn and associate back to Jack Kemp Community School and the LPSD programs.
- Thank you to those parents who helped out with the fall fundraiser, attended the LPSD SCC Meeting, Craft Fair, picture retakes, organizing the Christmas Meal and Student Led Conference meal.
- Playground update: Looking for thoughts about an outdoor classroom/seating area for the front of the school. Mrs. Gordon will look into cost for this and then present to SCC for a possible contribution towards this.
- Reading Benchmarks update: Grades 2-6
 - 15% are reading below average
 - 33% are reading at grade level
 - 52% are reading above grade level !!
- Attendance Update: starting in the month of December teachers will receive a printout of attendance and try to connect with families about "on-time-ness" and attendance in general. Teachers will be able to nominate a student from their class with IMPROVED attendance for a chance at a literacy gift for the student and a grocery gift card for the family. September and October attendance was not too bad, November typically depends on weather and illnesses.
- EYE testing will be happening this month for Pre-K and Kindergarten students, results will be available at the next meeting.

Over 200 people through the doors (not too shabby for our 1st year) and 6 full boxes of food bank donations from admission. A few little tweaks for next year, but a huge success. Will need to deliver the food donations to the food bank this week.
- Christmas Meal will be held on December 10, 2018. We have contracted Days Hotel here in Lloydminster to cater the meal, they came back with a great price of \$6.00 per plate for the full turkey meal. We will purchase the cookies, juice boxes and buns from the Lloydminster Co-op and order the cutlery and butter through Mrs. Korn's suppliers. Students will receive an

appropriate grade level book from the SCC this year instead of the goody bag as they have in the past. A group of SCC parents is getting together to wrap the books as gifts. The Lloydminster Bobcats Junior A Hockey team will be in attendance to help set up and serve the Christmas Meal. Set up for the meal will be Monday, December 10 morning. We will need 5 vehicles available at 11:00 a.m. to pick up the food from the caterer.

- Cookie Dough pick up will be tomorrow from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. This will be the last pick up date for the items.
